

INTERNSHIPS

Hands-on experience is a curriculum requirement, and each student must complete an average of 5 weeks' internship per year in order to graduate.

Our students come from underprivileged backgrounds, and have had little to no exposure to the industry they are training for. So, introducing them by immersion is invaluable.

SELECTION PROCESS

Though we have 40 students, we selected only those who we felt were ready. Additionally, students below the age of 14 were discounted on labour law grounds.

THE RESULT?

27 students were hosted by 7 different companies for the month of August - and it was a wonderful success.

We are immeasurably grateful to those who took on the challenge of mentoring young learners in the midst of a busy high season - thank you!
