Did you know that Africa Amini Alama currently educates over 2,500 children? Our vision is to give children and young people the tools to shape their own lives, through the transfer of knowledge and the acquisition of practical skills.

In addition to the students acquiring knowledge, creativity and independent thinking, we aim to help them become responsible members of their communities.

Three English-medium primary schools, support for four English-medium government schools, and three secondary schools: Pamoja Secondary, Kilimo Secondary School for Regenerative Agriculture, and AASSIST.

Our vocational training schools teach adolescents a trade in order to integrate them into a stable working environment as early as possible. Our offerings:

- Bricklaying, carpentry, welding and mechanics
- Tailoring
- Computer school
